



Funeral Arrangement Checklist

At the time of loss - In order to ease the anticipation of what happens next, we have developed this partial guide to provide guidance and helpful information.

The following information about your loved one will be needed at your initial counseling call:

- Decedent's Social Security number
- Date and place of birth
- Address at the time of death
- Marital status and the surviving spouse's name, if applicable
- Family members names and contact information
- Veterans discharge papers (DD-214) if applicable
- Father's name
- Mother's full name, including maiden name
- Place of death
- Highest level of education and occupation
- Will you want Taharah or a Shomer?
- Number of Death Certificates needed?
- Will you need to purchase property?
- Will you need transportation (limousines)?

Additional items and information that will be needed prior to your service:

- Pre-planned funeral arrangements or documents in which your loved one has made his or her final wishes known, if applicable
- Clothing, including undergarments
- Eyeglasses and jewelry (these items may remain with your loved one or be removed and returned after the service)
- A recent photograph (we will use this for cosmetic purposes)
- Military discharge papers for a veteran, if applicable
- Names and contact information for six to eight pallbearers, if applicable
- Pictures for display at the time of services
