

Decoration Policies

DECORATIONS

No planting or artificial flowers, will be allowed on the interment spaces and no planting or the like, will be allowed in any case except that which is done by Mount Sinai Memorial Parks.

The use of artificial or so-called everlasting flowers or plants, shrubs, or flowers treated so that they will be long lasting is prohibited.

Memorialization through the use of memorial tablets, cut flowers, and windmills (18" in height max) are allowed only within the physical boundaries of an individual interment/entombment space. In an effort to be sensitive to the feelings of all property owners and with concerns for maintaining the safety and beauty of the park, a combined limit of three items per interment/entombment space will be allowed.

"Temporary" vases are provided by Mount Sinai Memorial Parks for the convenience of visitors to display cut flowers for the life of such flowers. When such flowers become unsightly Mount Sinai staff will remove them. The placement of these vases is limited to the area within the boundary of the interment space. There is a limit of 3 temporary vases per interment space for the display of cut (not artificial) flowers only.

Placement of any decorations ON the memorial tablet is not allowed as damage to the tablet may occur. The placement of borders of rocks, shells or other materials around and/or on top of the memorial tablet is not allowed due to the danger of these items becoming propelled through the air at the time these areas are trimmed or mowed. **Jerusalem Stones** provided by Mount Sinai Memorial Parks are acceptable for placement on the tablet to indicate visitation **are safe for use and recommended**. We offer these stones free to you in our lobby.

In order to maintain a uniform beauty in the mausoleums, the affixing of photographs, cardboard or paper, flowers, lipstick, graffiti by any means including tape and glue, is not permitted. Such applications can cause damage to the crypt front stone.

LIABILITY FOR FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Mount Sinai Memorial Parks will not be liable for floral pieces, baskets or frames in which or to which such floral pieces are attached, beyond the acceptance of such floral pieces for the services held in Mount Sinai Memorial Parks

MAUSOLEUM-WALL CRYPT AREAS

Expectorating or smoking within the structures is strictly prohibited.

All improvements or decoration of individual property in the mausoleum and wall crypt areas shall be under the direction and subject to the approval of Mount Sinai Memorial Parks.

No special embellishment, such as statuary, vases other than regulation crypt front vases, etc., may be placed in family sections which have been subdivided without written consent of Mount Sinai Memorial Parks and all owners in said family section.

Only vases of uniform size and design may be used in the placing of flowers on crypts. These will be furnished by Mount Sinai Memorial Parks.
